Open to Orleans High School students
“War of 1812 in Orleans, MA”

During the War of 1812 – 1814, Orleans actively participated with a volunteer militia of over 70 men, seafaring Naval recruits, and even engaged in a battle with the British Navy at Rock Harbor. Stories and details can be found on our website orleanshistoricalsociety.org “War of 1812” web page.

Several events and exhibits are planned for this summer in Orleans: Tchaikovsky's famous 1812 Overture performed by the POPS in the Park, a militia encampment, fife and drum corps performance, museum exhibit, historic walks and more!

A good logo or artwork truly is a thousand words, if not many, many more. It tells you almost everything you need to know about the people it represents, and often does so without any words at all. Graphic design that sums up what we are celebrating. In this competition open to Orleans High School students, we are looking for a graphic design that conveys the historical and cultural importance of this event in Orleans. Artwork may be printed full color for print applications, but also done as a one, two, or three spot colors onto mugs and other items. To make it even more interesting, this needs to be something that can be used almost anywhere: flags, t-shirts, pins, letterhead, mugs, and more. Please try to work for a VERTICAL layout.

You have to submit your design by noon, Eastern time, March 1, 2012.

A \$50 cash prize will be awarded to the winner along with public announcement and your name credit where applicable.

Of course, there are some rules and regulations that go with any contest:

1. Any individual can submit only 1 design. Each submission must include the name of the artist, phone number, e-mail, and address. Please sign your work near, but not on, the design.
2. Initial submissions can be made as a JPEG or similar file, or as original artwork.
3. By submitting artwork to the contest, the person submitting same confirms that they are the creator; that non-exclusive rights to the artwork are given to Orleans Historical Society and its agents; that as part of that Orleans Historical Society and its agents have the right to print that artwork in any medium or format for any and all purposes; to display said artwork in any medium or manner; and, to do so with out compensation or other indirect payment.
Plain English Translation: This means we can post them to the web to display; print and hang them on the wall; or, use them in a book, brochure, or whatever (think history book as one example) with the only compensation being whatever publicity it brings you. You can use it too, on your site, clip book, etc.
4. The artwork chosen becomes the property of Orleans Historical Society. The artist will retain the right to use the logo/artwork on their site or in print materials as an example of their work. The original artwork is subject to modification, alteration, or other adjustments as needed now or in the future.
5. Orleans Historical Society and its agents assumes no liability or responsibility for any real or claimed losses, hardship, or other impact to the submitter; nor does Orleans Historical Society or

its agents assume any liability for copyright or other claims, and all such responsibility and liability rests with the person submitting the artwork.

Plain English Translation: We are accepting the submission in good faith.

We are not responsible for any costs, fees, or other impacts you incur as a result of your submission; and, if you submit something that infringes on copyright or other legal protection of another person or party, all costs and liability for that infringement rest with you.
