After operating a studio/gallery in Provincetown for many years, nationally acclaimed folk artist Peter Hunt moved to Orleans in the late 1950s where he opened a store called “Peacock Alley” and became a town celebrity. **The exhibition includes more than 30 examples of Hunt’s art on loan from local collectors and from the CHO archives, most of which have not been seen in public.** Additional programming is being planned around the exhibition and will be announced soon.
